The Council met at the Seagraves City Hall 309 Hill St.

- 1) **Call to Order-Announce Quorum:** 06:30PM
- 2) **Pledge of Allegiance:** Rick Dollahan
- 3) **Invocation:** Ruben Valles
- 4) **Roll Call:** Gary Cole, Debra Middleton, Cindy Durham, Ruben Valles, Lorena Davila-Absent
- 5) **Approve Minutes of the Previous Meeting:** Motion to approve by Alderman Durham, Second by Alderman Middleton. Motion passed by unanimous vote.
- 6) **Discuss and take action as necessary regarding Swimming Pool Operations for the Summer 2022 Season:** Alderman Cole motion to have Vickie Rodriguez manage the pool again this year, Second by Alderman Durham. Motion passed by unanimous vote.
- 7) **Discuss and take action as necessary regarding upgrading holiday decorations along Main Street:** The Mayor directed the Public Works Director to gather information regarding price and type of available items and to be prepared to discuss the matter in grater detail at the next meeting.
- 8) **Consent Agenda:** Motion to accept department reports by Alderman Durham, Second by Alderman Middleton. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

- 10) **New Business:** The Mayor updated the council regarding the sale of stressed and abandoned properties at the recent Sheriff Auction.
